Mrs. Onie Re Pate was born October 25, 1921 in Oxford Mississippi to the union of Reverend Vassie and Rosetta Cosby. Both parents and eight siblings preceded her in death.

Onie loved the Lord and confessed a belief in Christ at an early age.

Onie attended the Mississippi School System in Oxford Mississippi. In 1945, the family migrated to St. Louis, Missouri and joined Pleasant Green Missionary Baptist Church, under the leadership of the late Reverend G.H. Pruitt.

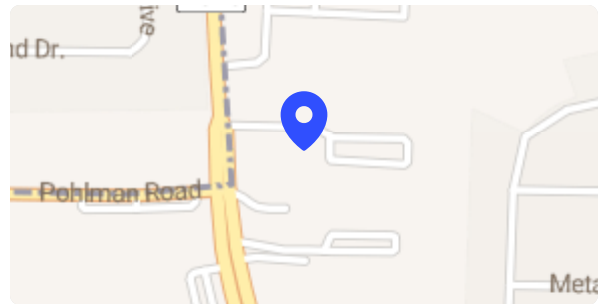

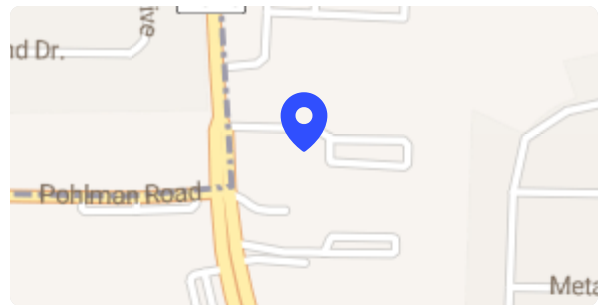

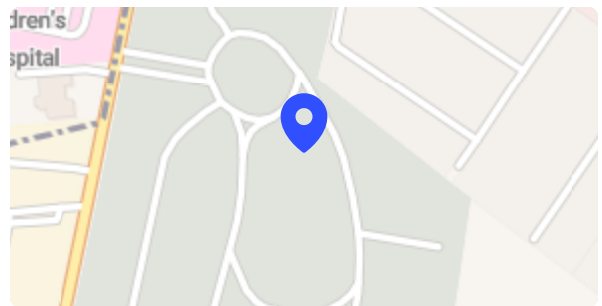
