family/friends, and fishing.

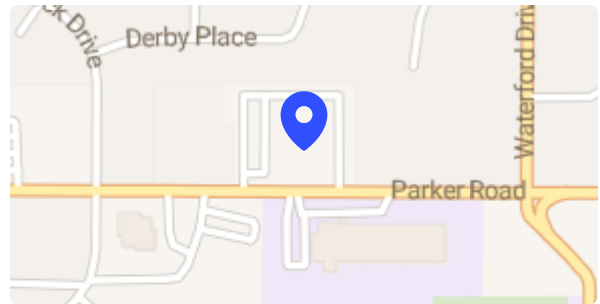
He was preceded in death by his parents Charlie and Willie Mammie Dixon, his siblings Emma, Odessa, Tommy and Charlie Dee.

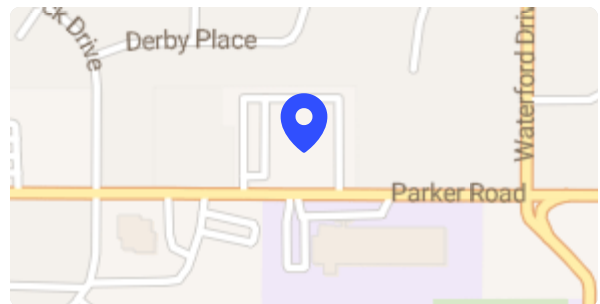

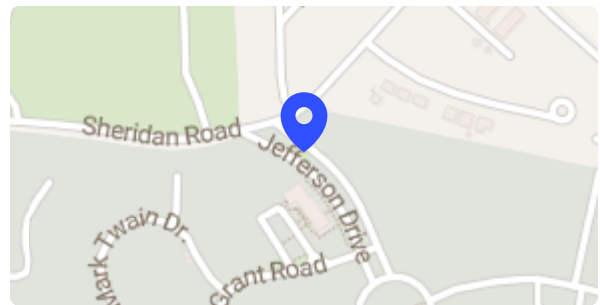
