Joseph Zanders passed away from this life on to glory on Friday, August 24, 2018. He was born on March 12, 1932 in Pine Bluff, Arkansas to Richard A. Zanders and Loretta Bess.

As a young man, he joined the United States Army and while stationed near Lafayette, Louisiana, he met the love of his life, Mary Allen Martin. From this union came six lovely children: Vickie, Gary, Cathy, Larry, Joseph, Jr., and Sonja, all born in various parts of the country and abroad.
