As a child he was comical, mischievous, and loved sweets; like sweet cereal for example. He attended Sumner High School where he graduated in the class of 1988 along with a forever lasting brotherhood. He had an amazing work ethic which started out when he worked at the Central West End Shoe Repair in St. Louis, where he met his late wife Meschele Davis. They married in 1991 and joined the Nation of Islam in 1993. Together the couple had daughter Quinneta Meschele Davis (1992) and many years later, he produced son Quentin Montavias Davis Jr. (1999).
