Bordeaux; and a host of cousins, other relatives and many, many friends.






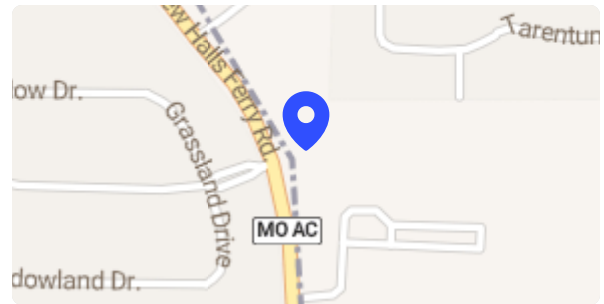
