A devoted family man, Stanley cherished his wife, Molly Lyons, with whom he shared 46 wonderful years of marriage. He was a proud father to Stephanie and Shante, and a loving grandfather to Brooke, Kaelyn, and Amiri.

Stanley was a remarkable individual with a strong and bold personality. He was known for his kindness and his strong intuition. He was an incredible athlete in his youth, having been a boxer, and he proudly served in the United States Army as a Medic during the Vietnam War. 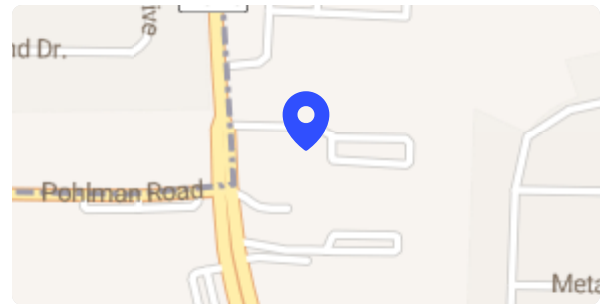

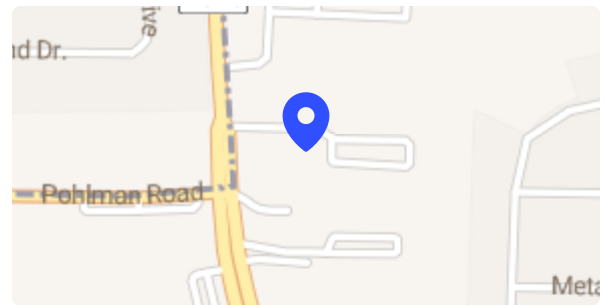

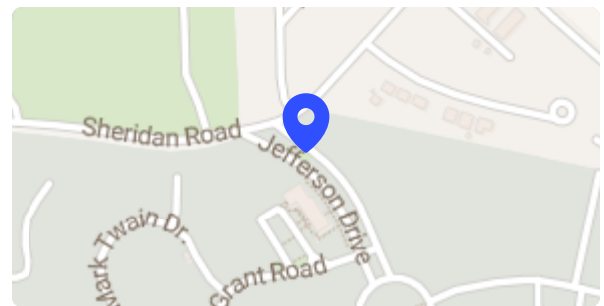
